The Blair County Planning Commission states that Blair County adopted its Comprehensive Plan in August, 2007. The above-referenced project is consistent with the county comprehensive plan in the concepts presented at this time. While further reviews may be necessary at various jurisdictional levels, the general concept is needed, and conforms with countywide planning efforts.

While this project generally conforms to the *Areawide Comprehensive Plan for Blair County*, the project applicant should ensure that more than adequate attempts have been made to garner public and municipal input on this project in the areas directly affected by the installation of this pipeline.

Additionally, we recommend that the applicant takes every effort to minimize impacts on streams/wetlands and, in the event of a spill, proper mitigation measures are in place to prevent contamination or destruction of these precious resources.

In summary, should the project applicant sufficiently notify the public and municipal leaders in affected areas and address any concerns they may have, as well as minimize environmental impacts in sensitive areas, then this proposal conforms to countywide planning efforts as presented in the *Areawide Comprehensive Plan for Blair County*.
