The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the above referenced application package and has determined that it is incomplete. The following list specifies the items missing from the submission which must be included in the resubmittal of your application and/or the submission of additional information. The items are based on applicable laws and regulations, and the guidance sets forth DEP's preferred means of satisfying the applicable regulatory requirements.

Please note that this information must be received within sixty (60) calendar days from the date of this letter, on or before **August 26**, **2025**, or DEP may consider the application withdrawn.

Items Missing from Submission

1. The Permit Fee Impact Summary Table in the ARIT and the Application Fee Worksheet appear to show inconsistent impact values. Please review and revise the application to ensure consistency. Note that all impact values must be rounded up to the nearest 0.1 acre, as required by the instructions in 3150-PM-BWEW0553. [25 Pa code §105.21(a)(1)]

Please use the Reference Number 324356 and PIN 880446 in the resubmittal to Public Upload with Payment.

You may request a time extension, in writing, before **August 26**, **2025** to respond to the deficiencies beyond the sixty (60) calendar days. Requests for time extensions will be reviewed by DEP and considered. You will be notified in writing of the decision either to grant or deny, including a specific due date to respond if the extension is granted. Time extensions shall be in accordance with 25 Pa. Code §105.13a(b).

The PAyback program amends the former Permit Decision Guarantee program. Executive Order 2023-07 requires the Department to abide by established review times for each authorization. The PAyback program became effective November 1, 2023, as required by Executive Order 2023-07. Chapter 105 applications or registrations received by the Department on or after that date are subject to this policy and are potentially eligible for Pennsylvania's PAyback program. More information is available on the PAyback website.

As stipulated in 25 Pa. Code §105.13a of DEP's Chapter 105 Rules and Regulations (regarding Complete applications) information requested by this office must be received within sixty (60) calendar days from the date of this letter, on or before August 26, 2025, or DEP will consider the application to be withdrawn by the applicant and no further action will be taken on the application. Fees are not refunded when an application is considered to be withdrawn unless requested and eligible for Payback.
