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## WINTER PERIOD APPLICATION OF MANURE NOTIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

This form is to be completed when the permittee anticipates land applying manure during the winter period. This notice must be sent to DEP Central Office within 7 days prior to the anticipated land application of manure. Please provide a copy of any submitted form(s) to your commercial manure hauler/broker upon their request.

Identify the "Date of Submittal" from the original notification form that is being replaced. Complete the applicable *Field ID, Acres, Anticipated Volume (Ton or Gallons), and Anticipated Date* information on any resubmittals.
