Chapters 91 and 92a Fee Updates

- DEP Will Propose NPDES Permit Fees to EQB late 2016.
- All NPDES Permit Fees; Not Just CAFOs.
- Permit Fee Increase Necessary to Support Current Level of Effort.
- Follow-up From April AAB Meeting.




- The NPDES Program costs approx. \$20 million per year to administer.
 - ~\$3.6 million is collected through fees.
 - ~\$6.6 million from EPA grant.
 - ~\$9.8 million from General Fund.

~18% of program costs funded by fees




5-Year NPDES Fee Total for <u>1 MGD Sewage Discharger</u>






5-Year NPDES Fee Total for CAFO Permit



■ 5-Year Fee Total for CAFO Permit





Current Regulatory Requirements

- NPDES Individual Permit Application Fees:
 - CAFOs \$1500 for new
 - CAFOs \$750 for renewal
- NPDES Individual Permit Annual Fees:
 CAFOs \$0

These fees generate about \$25,000/year



To Be Proposed

As Proposed, Starting in 2018

- NPDES Individual Permit Application Fees:
 - CAFOs \$2000 for new
 - CAFOs \$1000 for renewal
- NPDES Individual Permit Annual Fees:
 - CAFOs \$1000

These new fees would generate about \$145,000/year



To Be Proposed

As Proposed, Starting 2023

- NPDES Individual Permit Application Fees:
 - CAFOs \$3000 for new
 - CAFOs \$1500 for renewal
- NPDES Individual Permit Annual Fees:

– CAFOs - \$1500

These new fees would generate about \$215,000/year

- Final Rule Published September 2017
