Performing Hazardous Waste Facility Inspections

- TGD 251-3120-001 was last updated in September 2005.
- Purpose
 - Establish a formalized framework for conducting HW facility inspections statewide.
 - Standardize the general procedure to the best extent possible.

Overview of Changes

- Addition of necessary definitions.
- Incorporate review or electronically accessible data systems.
- Standardize the types of inspections conducted and preparation for each
 - Compliance Evaluation Inspection
 - Follow-up Inspection
 - Administrative File Review
 - Groundwater Monitoring Evaluation



Significant Changes

- Addition of Administrative File Review.
 - Broadens definition of what may be included in a non-financial record review.
- Encourages inspectors to notate items that remain undetermined.
- Establishes a more frequent inspection frequency for permitted Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facilities (TSDFs).
