DEP Summary of Activities

Jay informed the group that Secretary Hanger signed the State Water Plan on Feb. 2, 2009. There will be a Ceremonial Event on March 26, 2009 with the location TBD. Watershed Verification Update

DRBC staff had also contacted stakeholders to discuss the verification results. Dave is planning a meeting of the technical subcommittee in April to evaluate in greater detail the verification results. At its next meeting the full committee will discuss which watersheds should become CWPA nominations.
