Enforcement Provisions – with Big Teeth

Policy for all Permit Reviews to look at the CARPs - make it a requirement

Re-evaluate existing Permits w/language for permit time limits

Discourage Inter-Basin transfers

Discourage Development in Source Water Protection Areas & Groundwater Recharge Areas

Stricter Groundwater Protection

New local regulations and zoning that tie to enforcement related to CARPs, etc

Prioritize grant funding to support CARPs

Prohibition for Gas well drilling in CARPs

Media Exposure on all items listed
