Comments from the Public

DEP Summary of Activities

Leslie informed the group that Secretary Hanger signed the State Water Plan on Feb. 2, 2009. There will be a Ceremonial Event on March 26, 2009 with the location TBD. All committee members are invited to attend. More details will follow soon. Copies of the State Water Plan will be given to all committee members and to individuals who request a copy. Copies of the Atlas will be sent to additional stakeholders including conservation

districts, county governments, watershed and conservation groups, school districts and libraries.

Watershed Verification Update

Dave Jostenski said that he has mailed letters to water operators and additional stakeholders regarding the watersheds undergoing verification in the basin, and he has received some comments back. He is meeting with the Gettysburg Municipal Authority next week. The technical subcommittee will meet on April 2 to evaluate in greater detail the verification results. At its next meeting the full committee will discuss which watersheds should become CWPA nominations.
