## Corrections to By-Laws:

## Article XI: Amendment of By-Laws

The By-Laws may be amended at any meeting of the Statewide Committee by two-thirds majority vote of the full voting Statewide Committee membership (16 voting members) provided that written notice of such change has been sent via email with a read receipt or email acknowledgement from each member at least two weeks prior to the meeting.

## Article VI: Voting

- A. Members shall be entitled to one (1) vote, in person or via teleconference or videoconference when applicable, on all matters that come before the Statewide Committee. The Chair and Vice-Chair shall be allowed to vote on all matters before the Statewide Committee.
- B. A majority of the membership of the Statewide Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of Statewide Committee business. Action may only be taken on a matter before the Statewide Committee by a majority vote (16 voting members) of the full voting membership of the Committee.
