Background

- Current Chapter 102 regulations effective November 19, 2010
- Per 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(b)(2) evaluate adequacy of fees and report to Environmental Quality Board (EQB)

Background

Table 1. Fee for Chapter 102 Permits Under 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(b)(1)

Fee Type	Permit Type	Fee
Base Administrative Filing Fee	General Permits (NPDES PAG-02 and ESCGP)	\$500
Base Administrative Filing Fee	Individual Permits (NPDES and E&S)	\$1,500
Disturbed Acreage Fee	All Permits	\$100 x each disturbed acre

Fees

- Fees:
 - Additional Administrative Filing Fee (i.e., Disturbed Acreage Fee)
 - Base Administrative Filing Fee not included if paid to Commonwealth

Program Costs and Fees Collected

- Fiscal Years (FY); 2013 – 2014, 2014 – 2015, 2015 – 2016, 2016 – 2017, and 2017 – 2018
- Program Costs = DEP Staff Costs (Central and Regional Offices)
- Fees Collected = Disturbed Acreage Fees

Projections

- Fiscal Years (FY); 2018 – 2019, 2019 – 2020, and 2020 – 2021
- Program Costs estimated to increase by 4%
- Fee Collected estimated to increase by 4.4% for FY 2018 – 2019 and then by 2.4% after that

Table 3. Projected Costs and Fees Collected Associated with the Chapter 102 Program

	FY 2018-19	FY 2019-20	FY 2020-21
Projected Program Cost	\$3,352,528	\$3,486,630	\$3,626,095
Projected Fees Collected	\$2,594,133	\$2,656,392	\$2,720,146
Projected Difference (\$)	-\$758,395	-\$830,238	-\$905,949
Ratio	77%	76%	75%

Recommendation

- Fees collected are projected to cover only about 75% of DEP's expenses to implement the Chapter 102 program over the next three years.
- DEP is recommending an increase in Chapter 102 fees and plans to begin drafting a proposed rulemaking to address the discrepancy in the costs and revenue to operate the Program.
