## CHAPTER 92a. NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM

## PERMITTING, MONITORING AND COMPLIANCE

#### § 92a.51. Schedules of compliance.

(a) With respect to an existing discharge that is not in compliance with the water quality standards and effluent limitations or standards in § 92a.44 or § 92a.12 (relating to establishing limitations, standards, and other permit conditions; and treatment requirements), the applicant shall be required in the permit to take specific steps to remedy a violation of the standards and limitations in accordance with a legally applicable schedule of compliance, in the shortest, reasonable period of time, the period to be consistent with the Federal Act. **Except as otherwise set forth in this subsection, a**[A]ny schedule of compliance specified in the permit must require compliance with final enforceable effluent limitations as soon as practicable, but in no case longer than 5 years, unless a court of competent jurisdiction issues an order allowing a longer time for compliance. **Compliance schedules granted to CSO dischargers may exceed 5 years but shall in no event exceed the period of implementation specified in an approved Long-Term Control Plan** (LTCP).
