In compliance with the provisions of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. Section 1251 *et seq.*, and Pennsylvania's Clean Streams Law, as amended, 35 P.S. Section 691.1 *et seq.*,

(facility operator) has certified that the subject facility meets the eligibility requirements for No Exposure Certification (Certification) as identified in the No Exposure Certification Instructions (3800-PM-BCW0083f) and is hereby acknowledged as conditionally excluded from the requirement to obtain coverage under an NPDES permit for stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity.

This Certification is subject to the following further qualifications:

1. The condition of no exposure must be maintained facility-wide to remain eligible for the conditional exclusion from NPDES permit coverage. If conditions change, the operator named above must notify DEP and immediately seek coverage under the PAG-03 General Permit or an individual NPDES permit.
2. A new No Exposure Application (3800-PM-BCW0083e) and PAG-03 Notice of Intent (NOI) (3800-PM-BCW0083b) must be submitted every five years to renew the Certification, at least 180 days prior to the expiration date specified above.
3. In the event that the facility operator changes, the current as well as the new operator must complete and submit the Application for NPDES or WQM Permit Transfer form (3800-PM-BCW0041b) to DEP at least 30 days prior to the change in operators.
4. This Certification does not authorize construction or modification of facilities necessary to meet the conditions of the Certification.
