- General Permit for Discharges from Hydrostatic Testing of Tanks and Pipelines
- Expires on April 21, 2027
- 16 facilities are covered under PAG-10
- Draft permit available (published on August 22, 2026)

- NOI Instructions have been modified to update links
- NOI Instructions have been modified to clarify conditions in which PAG-10 coverage may be unnecessary
