

THE PA DEP HAS BROKEN THE CONSTITUTION AND IS

EMPLOYEES. These violations range from human rights
violations per the PA Constitution, negligence, to a breach of your
ethics code, as you have completely decimated the public's trust.
We are in a global climate crisis due to negligent corporation and
government practices, especially including those of the United
States, as we are seeing here today. You showing us 17 data
center projects, 3 planned along the delaware river to my
knowledge if not more, in a climate crisis can only be interpreted
by citizens and environmental scientists in no other way besides
public endangerment. These projects will only accelerate the
climate crisis, and they ARE against the common wealth contrary
to what was said today, because these projects are against the
people's environmental values and are collectively an extreme
health and safety hazard. You are ALL aware of the climate crisis,
per the coral bleaching levels, sea and land temperatures, more
extreme weather events, increased toxin levels, massive

pollinator and biodiversity loss, and so forth. These of which have led to excessive ecological overshoot for our Earth, increased health issues, and hazardous living conditions for generations to come. Yet the DEP still continuously deregulates, allows over industrialization, and unsustainable processes for the sole purpose of profit and control, at the cost of citizens health, safety, and wellbeing. And if the DEP leaders claim they not aware of climate crisis science, as the head of the PA DEP did to me, then they too are guilty of improper research per your scientific and ethical standards, and further negligence and endangerment. The PA DEP's obvious guilt and distrust you have created comes down to each of its so called leaders, making them all liable as individuals, as is the entirety of the DEP as an entity. We demand the PA DEP all resign effectively immediately, and that you be held liable in a court of law, addressed by the police or the citizens. How dare anyone in the DEP call themselves protectors as we have seen nothing but the selling out and mass destruction of this country's environments exponentially these past years. The DEP is not exempt from the consequences of repeatedly harming, threatening, and disrespecting our life, liberty, environments, and property, including for the sake of progress in industrial zones. You must be held accountable, and the entire organization must be regulated in order to benefit the people, and truly combat the

climate crisis. THIS is The Will of The People. We the citizens are the top of the DEPs chain of command. And anyone preventing solutions, and allowing businesses to accelerating the climate crisis without community approval and genuine benefit, are without a doubt considered a threat, and an enemy to our both our Constitution, and The People, of both America and the global collective. The PA DEP should expect the legal repercussions which the citizens have the right to take, and i hope they collectively evoke. The DEP still has the chance to lead with genuine sustainability and environmentally compatible energy, materials, and systems, and to stop these data centers. But from what I have seen and heard today, the PA DEP and this council only have intent to further the climate crisis and to allow nuisances and hazards which will endanger PA and neighboring states, especially New Jersey. It the time for real environmental protection, not the protection of the agency for profit, at the environment's sake. It is time for real climate action and accountability.
