 - Stream redesignation information




Stream Redesignation Petition


- Submit petition to EQB via Policy Office
- Completeness review
- Present to EQB for consideration
- If accepted by EQB for further study,
 - Department conducts biological survey; file search; and public information request



Current Designation: WWF



Proposed Designation: Special Protection



Basis of the Petition

 The petitioner believes an assessment of the submitted information and subsequent independent evaluation will qualify the petitioned streams for Special Protection.

 The department recommends the acceptance of this petition for further study.










Upper Paradise Creek, Monroe County Stream Redesignation Petitions
