Pursuant to the requirements of Section 7.6 of the Air Pollution Control Act, on March 2, 2016, staff from the Bureau of Air Quality briefed the Citizens Advisory Council (Council) Policy and Regulatory Oversight Committee (Committee) on the proposed rulemaking for the Repeal of Gasoline Volatility Requirements. The proposed rulemaking amends 25 Pa. Code Chapter 126, Subchapter C, by repealing regulations relating to the gasoline volatility requirements as required by Act 50 of 2014.

On the recommendation of the Committee, Council voted at their March 15, 2016, meeting to concur with advancing the above-referenced proposed regulations to the Environmental Quality Board for action.
