


Stream Redesignation Petition


- Submit petition to EQB via Policy Office
- Completeness review
- Present to EQB for consideration
- If accepted by EQB for further study,
 - Department conducts biological survey; file search; and public information request



Current Designation: HQ-TSF



Proposed Designation: EV



Basis of the Petition

- Water quality and biological data was provided in support of the petition for Marsh Creek.
- The petitioner believes an assessment of the petitioned stream will qualify it for Exceptional Value redesignation.



Department Findings

- Petition is complete
 - Information requirements have been met as defined in §23.2 of the EQB petition policy
- This redesignation request does not conflict with federal law
- The Department recommends the acceptance of the Marsh Creek petition
