Blasts shall be designed and conducted to achieve either a minimum scaled distance of 90 or meet the maximum allowable peak particle velocity indicated by Figure 1 of PA Code Chapter 211.151 (c) and not exceed the noise levels specified in Table 1 of PA Code Chapter 211.151 (d) at the closest building not owned or leased by the permittee or its customer.

The Department may establish an alternative peak particle velocity or airblast level if it determines that an alternative standard is appropriate. Request for the Department to establish an alternative peak particle velocity or airblast level must be submitted to the Department Blasting and Explosives Inspector in writing. (attachment) NOTE: Additional review time will be necessary if the applicant requests that the Department establish an alternative peak particle or airblast limit.

Blasting Inspector's Comments for BAP 32254001

- 1. An alternative air overpressure limit of 140 dBL shall apply to this permit for all monitoring locations
- 2. The permittee shall monitor the atmosphere for signs of an atmospheric thermal inversion. Blasting shall not be conducted during observed thermal inversion conditions.
- 3. Blocking of all public roads is to be coordinated with the appropriate transportation authorities and/or law enforcement.
- 4. Permittee is reminded that there is no unattended storage of explosives on the site without first obtaining a Site Security Plan and Magazine Storage Licenses. All explosives are to be attended at all times and all unused explosives are to be removed at the completion of blasting activities.
- 5. The initial permit applies only to the concrete cooling towers and chimneys on the plant property as identified in this permit. The applicant will submit an addendum to this permit prior to each phase of the blasting to be conducted.
- 6. This permit authorizes blasting activity only. Additional state or local permits may be required for this or related activities.
