

NON-CONSISTENCY – MUNICIPAL STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

Dear Ms. Silva,

In response to your recent requests and evaluating the information you provided, Blair Township, Blair County, PA is <u>NOT</u> able at this time to verify that the proposed Sunoco pipeline installation project within Blair Township is consistent with Blair Township's Stormwater Management Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2011-08. The ordinance requires the submission of a stormwater management plan to the township for review and approval for ground surface changes of 5,000 sq. ft.

The Nov. 10, 2015 submission contains insufficient detail to determine if the project would create this 5,000 sq. ft. ground surface change. If you are able to submit more detailed plans that clearly show the location, dimensions, and permanent surface cover of the block valve station or any other facility which will create a permanent impervious surface proposed within the township limits, we can then reconsider your request.
