## **MAJOR PERMIT** MODIFICATION

The Delaware County Solid Waste Authority will file a Major Permit Modification application for its Rolling Hills Land-fill, located in Earl Township, PA, with the Southcentral Regional Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (Department) on or about September 29, 2017. This application will be submitted in conformance with provisions of Pennsylvania Code Title 25, Chapter 273, relating to municipal waste landfills.

The Major Permit Modification application requests Department approval to modify the facility's disposal capacity through the use of a mechanical stabilized earth berm and a later expansion of the disposal area. The application also requests Department approval for design alternatives related to grad-ing of final slopes (i.e., 20 feet wide ter-races within the final cover system spaced at a maximum vertical separation of 40 feet) and modification of the protective cover gradation. Both of the aforementioned design alternatives have been previously approved by the Department at other
