

## Adelphia Gateway Project - French Creek MLV and Transco Meter Station




Project Boundary

NV5, LLC (NV5) on behalf of Adelphia Gateway, LLC (Adelphia) is submitting this PNDI review request for the Adelphia Gateway Project (Project). The intent of this PNDI request is to provide PNDI-jurisdictional agencies with notification of changes to two of the Project components since NV5's last PNDI review request:

- Transco Meter Station (39°49'7.40"N, 75°26'5.55"W) Adelphia intends to modify the work area of the Transco Meter Station. NV5 surveyed this area during its original wetland and waterbody delineations for the Project and did not identify either of these resources in the area being considered for workspace changes.
- French Creek Blowdown Assembly Valve (40°8'0.21"N, 75°32'56.35"W) Adelphia intends to make minor modifications to the French Creek Blowdown Assembly Valve work area and access road due to constructability and engineering concerns. NV5 surveyed this area during its original wetland and waterbody delineations for the Project and did not identify either of these resources in area that would be affected by the modifications.

The changes to the proposed facilities are reflected in revised polygons on the interactive map available on the PNDI project page. No additional Project modifications are proposed at this time. Please reach out with any questions or additional data needs you may have.
