Dear Mr. Pavia:

The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") has previously communicated with you by letter regarding Christiana Metals Corporation ("Christiana") and the Bishop Tube site ("Site") in Frazier, East Whiteland Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

The Department's records indicate that Christiana owned and operated the Site from approximately 1974 through 2004, and thus may be responsible for any environmental investigations or cleanup actions necessary at the Site. As you may know, the Department is implementing response actions under the authority of Section 501 of the Pennsylvania Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act, 35 P.S. § 6020.501, including a remedial investigation of the contamination on the Site and the Department will shortly be moving into a remedial action phase after it selects an appropriate remedy.

As part of its investigation, the Department continues to seek information concerning a release and/or threat of release of contamination from the Site. The Pennsylvania Department of State lists you as a corporate officer of Christiana. In your capacity as a corporate officer, the Department hopes that you will be able to provide a response to the enclosed request for information.

The Department looks forward to your response regarding Christiana and its involvement at the Bishop Tube site. Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
