

# WE WANT TO HEAR FROM CHESTER RESIDENTS!

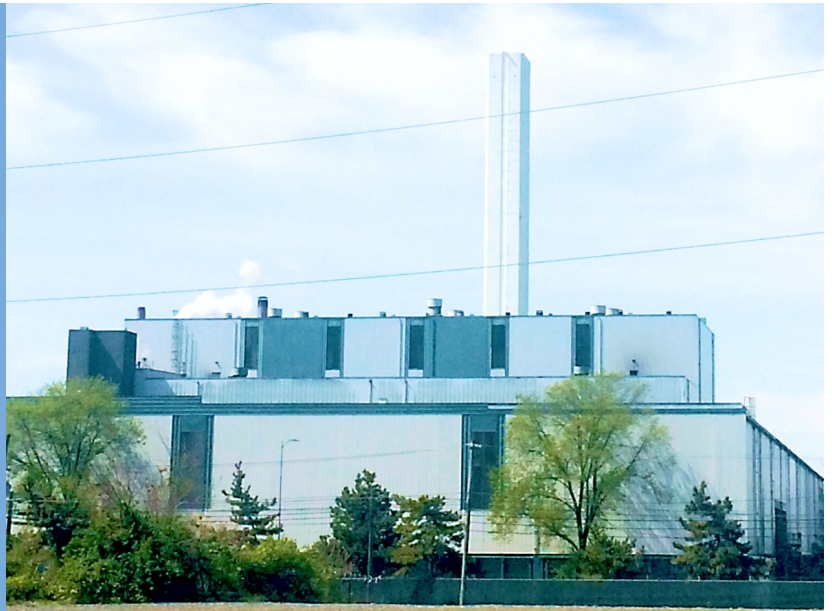
## What is this about?

Covanta Delaware Valley is a permitted municipal waste combustion facility, also known as a waste-to-energy plant, located at 10 Highland Avenue in Chester, PA. The facility is seeking to install equipment that would reduce the amount of the pollutant nitrogen oxides (NOx) emitted from the facility's six (6) waste combustors to meet new federal and state standards for air pollution. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is currently seeking public comments to assist in reviewing Covanta's Air Quality Plan Approval application request and rendering a decision.
