I write today regarding the Rockhill Environmental Preservation Society's (REPA) letter to the Department of Environmental Protection regarding the future of Rockhill Quarry.

According to REPA's correspondence on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024, REPA states that Heidelberg's letter failed to present any new information or arguments that have not already been addressed by REPA and Dr. Erskine. As outlined in REPA's letter, Heidelberg reiterated their claim that they can eliminate asbestos using methods other than ISO 10312, given that ISO 10312 does not prohibit them from doing so. REPA wishes to bring this to your attention and is hopeful your department will be able to make a decision based on this information.
