According to REPA's correspondence on June 12th, 2024, REPA states that Heidelberg's letter failed to present any new information or arguments that have not already been addressed by REPA and Dr. Erskine. As outlined in REPA's letter, Heidelberg reiterated their claim that they can eliminate asbestos using methods other than ISO 10312, given that ISO 10312 does not prohibit them from doing so. REPA wishes to bring this to your attention and is hopeful your department will be able to made a decision based on this information.
