You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of November 18, 2020, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

Since the last community update sent on October 16, 2020:

- On November 18, 2020, DEP requested additional and updated information from Hanson Aggregates, LLC., including current and intended operations at the quarry. Now that R.E. Pierson Materials has terminated its contract operator relationship with Hanson, Hanson is required to update information previously submitted in an existing permit modification application that was received by DEP on February 20, 2018. This information is due back to DEP by January 15, 2021.
- DEP continues to collect and analyze information regarding Naturally Occurring Asbestos at the site, including working with agency partners such as the US EPA and PA DOH.
