Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of February 11, 2022, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

This email is to provide notice that Hanson's consultant plans to be at the Rock Hill Quarry site on Monday (02/14/2022) to conduct topographic surveying of pond outfalls and other site features. No digging or earth disturbance will take place.

Hanson and/or its subcontractors will obey the speed limit of 15 mph intended to minimize/prevent fugitive dust emissions that could potentially be generated by passenger vehicles. Additionally, no large machinery will be utilized during site work.

DEP will be on site to monitor all activity.
