Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of May 27, 2022, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

This email is to provide notice that Hanson personnel (Hanson) are scheduled to be on site Wednesday June 1, 2022 to conduct the first round of Activity Based Sampling.

For this sampling event, Hanson does not intend to utilize a water truck as the maximum 15-mph speed limit will be observed. A smartphone based app will be used to create a track of the three (3) vehicles utilized for this limited activity event. Hanson expects the driving duration to be a minimum of two (2) hours for this event and will likely start between 10:00 and 11:00am.

PADEP Air Quality and Surface Mining Inspectors will be onsite for the duration of the sampling event.
