Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of June 21, 2021, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

Since the last community update sent on April 13, 2021:

- On Tuesday, June 22 and Wednesday, June 23, Hanson will be on site to collect soil, water, and air samples. A speed restriction of 15 MPH will be followed and only hand tools will be utilized. DEP will be on site to monitor this work.
- On June 14, 2021, Hanson sent DEP a request to extend the deadline to provide additional information and clarification in response to DEP's April 14, 2021 technical deficiency letter. Hanson requested this deadline be extended to October 29, 2021 from July 6, 2021. In a letter of June 21, 2021, DEP did not grant an extension to respond to items 1 through 10.d. However, an extension was granted to respond to items 10.e through 12.
