COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:										-
This inspection report is to note a violation. On 7/6/2018 there was a muddy discharge of water to an unnamed tributary of the Tohickon Creek from an area disturbed by mining. Sediment laden water from behind the garage was observed flowing in a channel along the north side of the old crusher area into the diversion swale. The diversion swale was to carry water from an undisturbed area only. This discharge was sampled (4519570) and resulted in a Total Suspended Solids (TSS) of 262 mg/L. Therefore Compliance Order 18-5-039-N is issued for failure to design/construct/maintain adequate erosion and sedimentation controls as per 25 Pa. Code Chapter 102 and permit conditions which incorporate the former 25 Pa. Code § 77.102 (c)(1). The operator shall design/construct/maintain erosion and sedimentation controls in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 77.102 (c)(1) and Pa. Code Chapter 102. The operator shall also submit a plan detailing the corrective action to be taken to prevent sediment laden water from the garage channel leaving the site. This plan should be submitted no later than 8 am on September 14, 2018 to the attention of Mr. Gary Latsha (Env. Group Mgr./DEP) in the Pottsville District Office.

Pursuant to §§ 5, 301, 307, 315, 316, 401, 402, 601, and 610 of the Clean Streams Law (35 P.S. §§ 691.5, 691.301, 691.307, 691.315, 691.316, 691.301, 691.401, 691.402, 691.601, and 691.610), §§ 4.2 and 4.3 of the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act (52 P.S. §§ 1396.4b and 1396.4c), § 11 of the Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, (52 P.S. § 3311), §§ 3.1 and 9 of the Coal Refuse Disposal Control Act, (P.L. 31, 52 P.S. § 1406.1), §§ 701-101 et seq., of the Bituminous Coal Mine Act (52 P.S. §§ 701-101) and Section 1917-A of the Administrative Code (71 P.S. § 510-17), and 25 Pa. Code §§ 86.211 and 86.213, it is hereby ordered that the operator shall perform the corrective actions listed in the attachment within the designated abatement time.

Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, P.O. Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure are also available in braille or on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at 717-787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.
