Narrative:

I went to visit the site to oversee the morning measuring and gauging event that is performed on the pre-determine residential potable wells and all four recovery wells. All wells that had absorbent booms, the depth to LNAPL and water were taken after they were removed from the well. Devin Graham and Kevin Troutman from GES arrived at 9:06am.

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Narrative (continued):

Observations from wells that were gauged:

RW-2

- The well was gauged after the absorbent sock, which was 100% saturated with LNAPL, was taken out of the well.
- There was a slight petroleum odor.
- The interface probe could not determine the LNAPL thickness, so a bailer was dropped and the LNAPL was measured to be 0.90-ft.
- The well was not bailed.

RW-3:

- The well had an absorbent sock in it, which was kept in for the gauging the depth of the LNAPL and water.
- There was a strong petroleum odor.
- The absorbent sock was 100% saturated with LNAPL.
- The sock was not replaced since the well might be pumped later in the day.
- The well was not bailed.

RW-4

- The well was gauged after the 4-foot absorbent sock was removed, which was estimated to be 50% saturated with LNAPL.
- I did not notice any petroleum odors.
- A new absorbent sock was put into the well.

- LNAPL was bailed until the LNAPL was 0.0-ft.
- After the depth to LNAPL and water was measured, the LNAPL was bailed until there was a measurement of 0.1-ft.
- There was approximately 1-gallon of water and LNAPL bailed, with about $\frac{3}{4}$ being LNAPL.
- There will be a sample of the LNAPL collected during the second round of gauging.

- I noticed a slight petroleum odor.
- After the depth to LNAPL and water was gauged, it was bailed down to a depth of 0.01-ft of LNAPL.
- Approximately 1-gallon was bailed from the well, $\frac{1}{2}$ LNAPL and $\frac{1}{2}$ water.

I was informed from GES that the LNAPL would be sampled after the 2nd round of gauging was performed.

I departed the neighborhood at 11:39 am and drove to the ET trailer to speak with anyone who might be there. There was no one present in the trailer.

I departed the site at 11:45am.

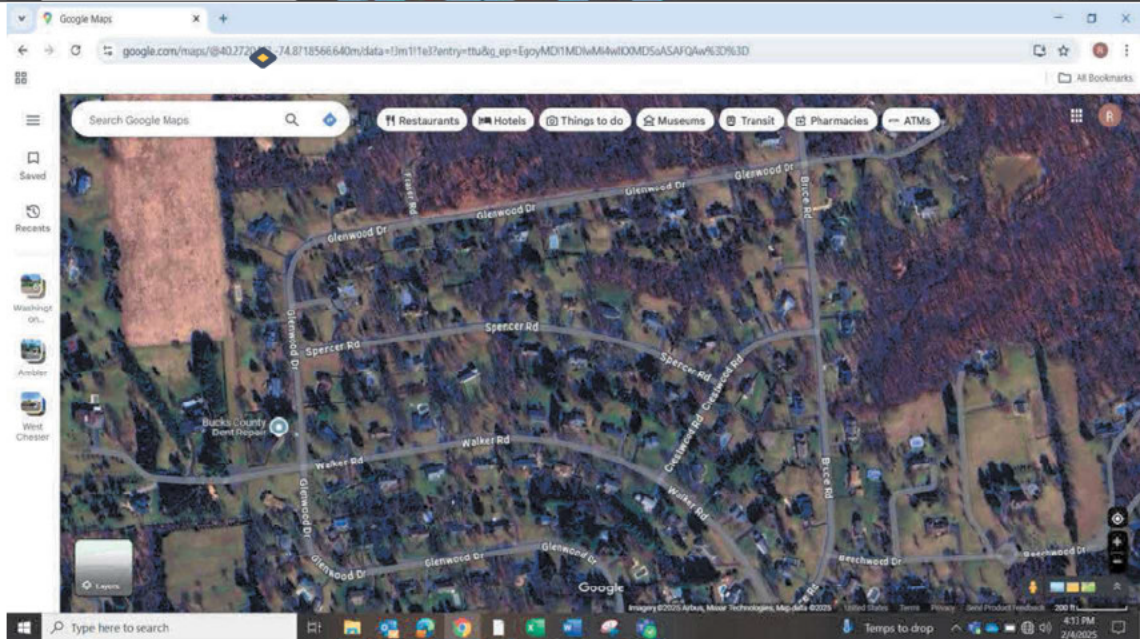
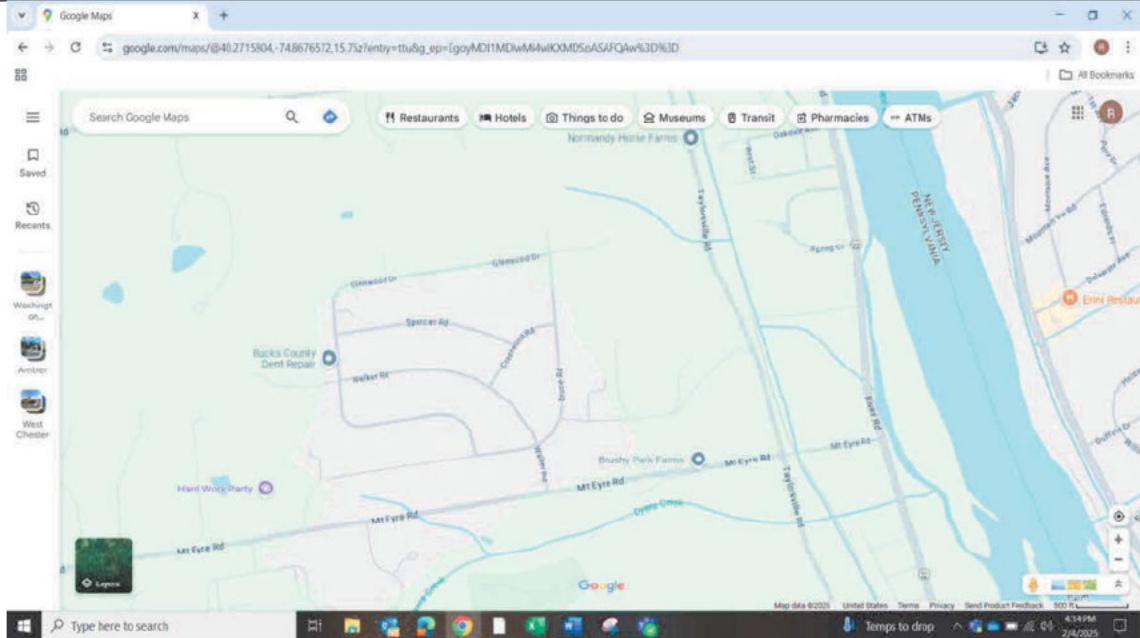
