I was told that there was no LNAPL that was measured in recovery well RW-3 today or yesterday, July 30, 2025.						
Activities MW-1S The drilling of monitoring well MW-1S started at 9:24am Soil samples were collected every five (5) feet while the well was being installed. The soil samples were placed on plastic sheeting to be screened and logged by GES. Competent bedrock and water was encountered around 20' below ground surface. The final depth of 45' below ground surface was reached at 9:52am.


