Narrative: I arrived at 8:58am near the intersection of Glenwood Drive and Walker Road.							
Installation of MW-6S: Before drilling of the monitoring well Chris told me that the goals for the day were to install monitoring well MW-6S and MW-7D. He went over the hazards at the drill site. Drilling of the well started at 9:35am. This well is located in the right of way in Glenwood Drive approximately 100 feet from the intersection of Walker Road and Glenwood Drive. Soil samples were collected every 5' for screening and logging and placed on plastic sheeting. PID readings were between 0.0 and 0.3 ppm. Wet soil was encountered at a depth between 35 and 40 feet below ground surface (bgs.) Groundwater appeared to have been encountered at approximately 35' bgs. Competent bedrock was not encountered during the installation of the monitoring well. There are three houses whose potable wells were monitored during the drilling of the well: and No response was received from the resident at Drilling ended at 10:05 when the target depth was reached of 45' bgs. The well was completed with 20' of riser and 20' of screen, I spoke with someone from Gilmore and Associates, engineers for Upper Makefield Township. He noticed there were areas where hydraulic oil was present on the road. He requested that I ask ET to put oil dry on it, which I relayed to Chris. Chris also informed me that they were going to get the street sweeper out today.






