Purpose: Drilling oversight.					
Weather: Sunny, mid 70's, light wind					
Narrative: I arrived at 8:50am to observe the installation of monitoring wells MW-9D and MW-9S. - The potable wells on [redacted] and [redacted] were gauged every two hours during the well installation. - The potable well on [redacted] was gauged every hour during the well installation. - At 9am, the drilling equipment was mobilized over the location of monitoring well MW-9D. - At 9:43am the drilling of MW-9D started. - Soil samples were collected every 5 feet, between 10 and 75-feet for screening and logging purposes. - There were four air summa canisters set up around the drill site to monitor for air quality. - The drilling stopped at 30-feet bgs for approximately 30 minutes to determine if any groundwater would migrate into the hole. - Saprolite was encountered at 8 feet bgs and competent bedrock was encountered at approximately 18 feet bgs. - The resident from [redacted] came and observed the drilling of the well periodically. - Water was encountered at an approximate depth of 50-feet bgs. - Drilling stopped at 11:10 when the target depth of 75 feet was achieved. - There were slight PID readings measured of 4.8ppm at 47 feet bgs and 13.6ppm at 49 and 50 feet bgs. Only monitoring well MW-9D was being drilled for the day, the rest of the day was for completing the well and soft digging the two locations for monitoring wells MW-10D and MW-10-S. A vacuum truck was brought on site to pump the water from the drilling area. All previous water and drill cuttings were placed into 55-gallon drums. I departed the site at 11:47am.					

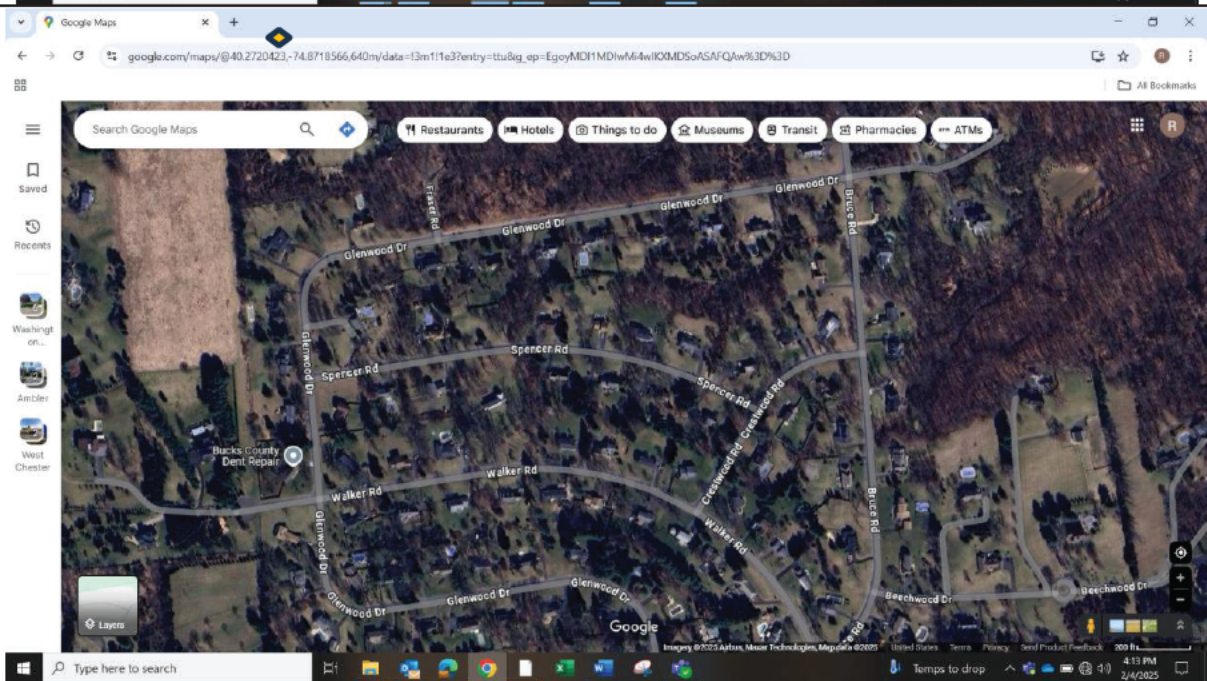
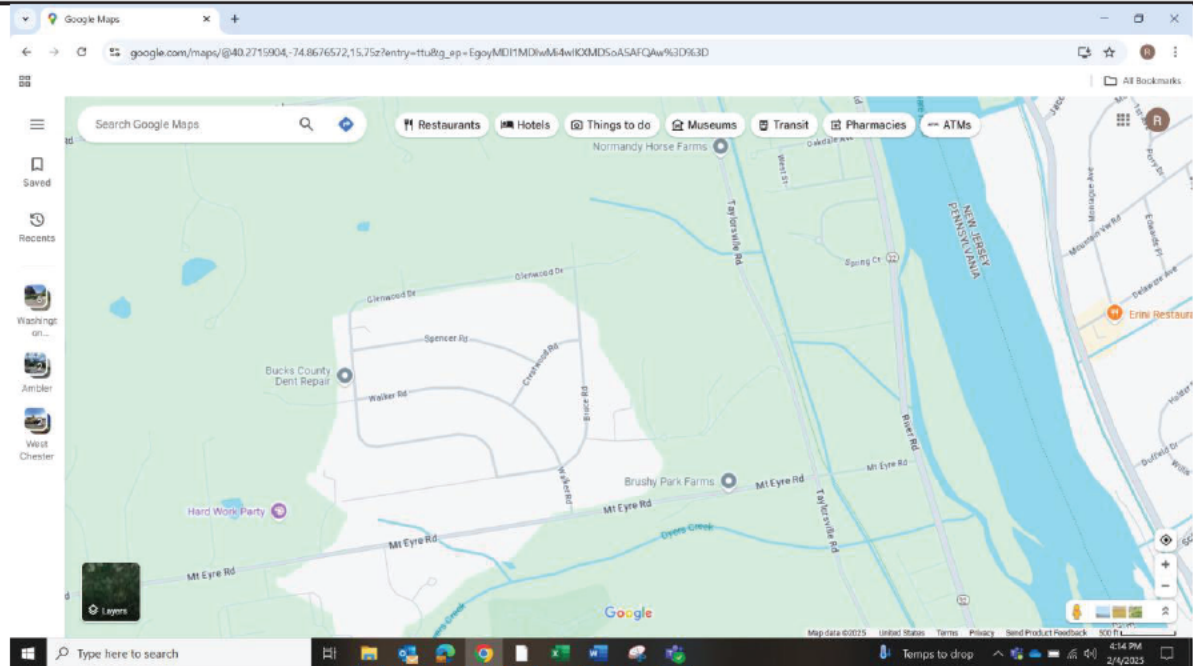
