

Weather: Cloudy and mid-50's								
Narrative: I arrived at the excavation site at 8:48am to observe the uncovering of the pipeline to determine if there was any evidence of a release. The excavation was part of routine maintenance for the pipeline. (see map below with red mark) The excavation of the soil had already begun when I arrived. There was one pile of soil, which was later informed that it was the topsoil that was going to be placed back on top after the replacement was performed. I was asked by the foreman for OTIS what to do with the water from the excavation. I informed him that the Department recommends having a vacuum truck to pump it out. As the excavation of the soil proceeded, it would stop about every 2-3 feet so that a metal pole could be used to determine how much further was needed to reach the pipe. (see picture below) I observed that about the top 6 feet of soil was tan, with rock fragments. It then turned into a tight grey/blue clay also with rock fragments to the bottom of the excavation was approximately 12-13 feet below ground surface (bgs). The soil on each side of the pipeline was carefully excavated to within about 2 feet from the pipe. I did not notice any odors while the soil was being excavated. Some water did								
infiltrate into the bottom of the excavation, there was no sheen observed on the water. At 13:35 as shoring was being unloaded onto the site to stabilize the excavation I departed.
