Purpose: Observe the pump test on new potable well installed on [REDACTED]					
Weather: Cloudy; 34°F					
Narrative:					
<u>Observations:</u>					
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Before the pump test began, I observed the skimmers being removed from recovery wells RW-2 and RW-3 on Glenwood Drive. - There was only a thin layer of LNAPL in RW-2, not enough to be able to collect a sample and in RW-3, there was no LNAPL in the skimmer. - The PID reading in RW-2 was 24.3ppm and 127.3ppm in RW-3. - I was informed that the County Health Department requires a peak flow test. The pump needs to be able to maintain a 7.0 gallon/minute for at least 40 minutes. Then a constant flow test needed to be performed for at least 60 minutes. - Before the pump test began, the depth to water in the new potable well was measured to be at 69-feet below top of casing. - I was informed by GES that the following addresses granted permission to gauge their wells during the test: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] - All the water pumped from the well was being put into a vacuum truck. - The pump that will be used for the test is the same one that will be installed for provide potable water to the house and was set a depth of 860-feet below top of casing. - Water was collected periodically from the well water to test the water parameters; pH, TDS (total dissolved solids), chlorine, and specific conductance. I did not notice any petroleum odors or sheen on the periodic water samples and the water appeared to be clear. - The peak flow test was run for 60 minutes, 20 minutes over the required 40 minutes. - After the two tests were performed, the depth to water was measured at 204.8 feet below top of casing. - I was informed by GES that the max drop in well depth was 0.18 feet and max increase of 3.7 feet in the wells being observed. - I was informed that a water sample was going to be collected. - I departed at 12:36 					

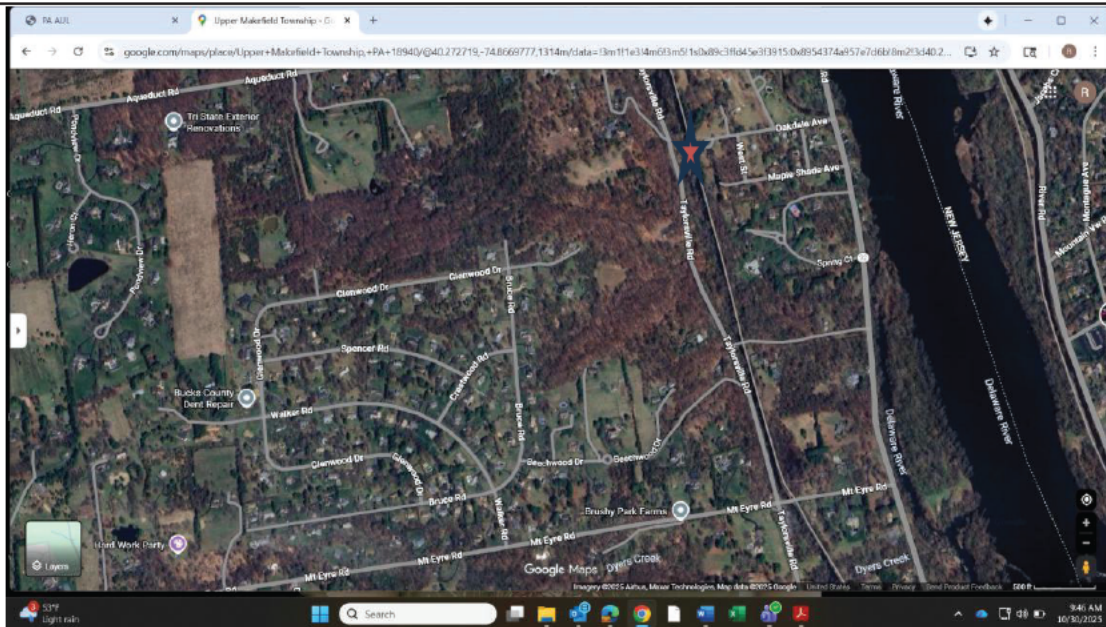
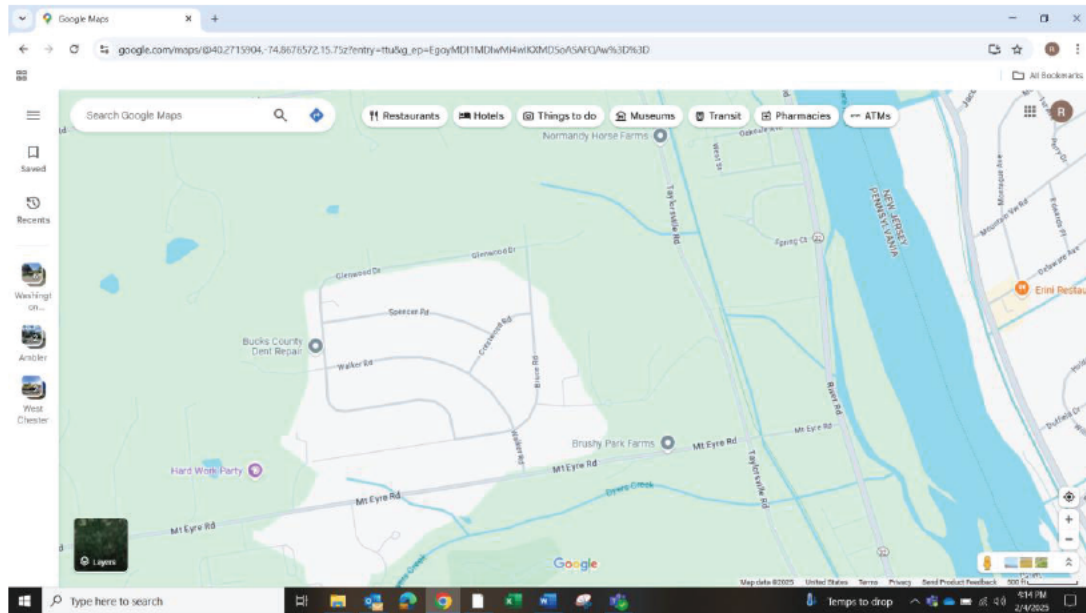

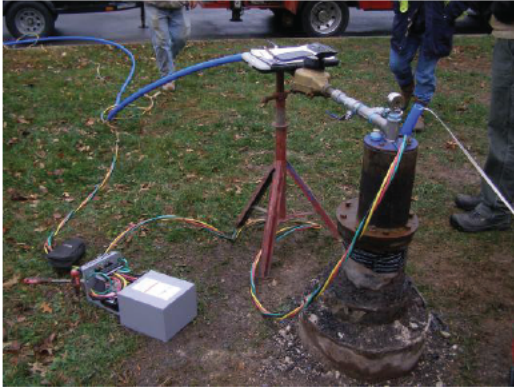

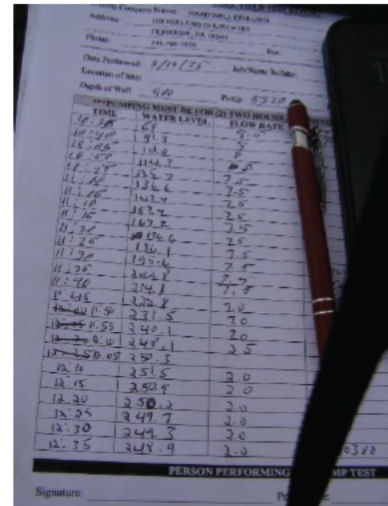
