Plans for Well Failures for Povlik Injection Well

If there is a well failure that involves equipment the well will be shut-in until the faulty equipment is repaired or replaced. If the failure poses no environmental or operational hazard, and the well has been returned to a safe operating condition, the well will be placed back into operation and nothing further will be done.

If there is any failure of mechanical integrity or some other major failure the well will be immediately shut-in and the Pennsylvania DEP and the EPA notified of the problem. Depending on the condition, the corrective action may include squeezing off the leak with cement or running an additional string of casing. The well will not be placed into service until it has been determined that the problem has been corrected and the EPA gives its approval to restart injection. Any fluid produced during the shut-in will be stored on site or disposed of at another approved facility.

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
