To Whom it May Concern:

Shell Chemicals Appalachia, LLC is writing to formally rescind the notification submitted to the National Response Center (NRC) on June 4, 2025, regarding Incident Report #1433121.

Following the initial notification, a detailed engineering analysis was conducted to quantify emissions associated with the event. This analysis utilized operational data and mass balance calculations based on the composition of the process gas stream. The evaluation included a hydraulic flow calculation and mass balance analysis to determine the volume of gas that entered the furnace, and the calculation of the total emissions released to the environment after combustion. This methodology ensured a comprehensive and accurate assessment of the event's environmental impact.

The results of the assessment confirmed that the facility did not release emissions exceeding the reportable quantity (RQ) for either Benzene or 1,3-Butadiene—substances that were initially reported out of an abundance of caution. The total quantities released during the event were determined to be:

- **1,3-Butadiene:** 6.26 pounds
- **Benzene:** 2.14 pounds

As these values are below the respective RQs, Shell Chemical Appalachia, LLC respectfully requests that the initial notification be withdrawn from the NRC record.
