



2009 Great American Cleanup of PA Summary Results

Summary

The following statistics reflect results from the 2009 Great American Cleanup of PA (GACPA) activities reported to PA CleanWays (PACW) and PennDOT through June 15, 2009. All related activities were events registered with PACW during March, April, and May 2009 or through PennDOT's Adopt-A-Highway Program (AAH).

As of June 15, 2009, the reporting rate for GACPA registered events through the GACPA website was 82% (701 out of 851). Therefore, the actual grand totals could be significantly higher. There was a chance that some registrants reported their results twice through the GACPA website and through the regular reporting of the AAH program. Any possible duplication was considered insignificant and the totals were added together for the purposes of determining grand totals for the 2009 GACPA.

All 67 counties in Pennsylvania were represented in the Great American Cleanup of PA in 2009. There were 4,837 events with 171,940 volunteers. Volunteers collected 344,021 bags of trash or 6,880,420 pounds. They cleaned 16,498 miles of roads, railroad tracks, trails, waterways, and shorelines, and 6,986 acres of park and or wetlands. Additionally, volunteers planted 6,264 trees, bulbs, and plants in an effort to keep Pennsylvania beautiful.



Highlights

- Registered Events and Volunteers Organizers in Bucks County were leaders in the cleanup effort with 285 registered events followed by Luzerne (284), Lancaster (232), Allegheny (203), and Chester (179) Counties. Volunteers in registered events in these five counties represented 27% of the total volunteers, accounting for 45,695 of the 171,940 volunteers.
- *Pounds of Trash* Volunteers in Allegheny County collected the most trash with an impressive total of 746,780 pounds. Volunteers in Philadelphia (715,080), Centre (461,780), Luzerne (437,120), and Northumberland (420,300) Counties rounded out the top five counties for pounds of trash collected.
- Miles Cleaned Volunteers in Philadelphia County cleaned more roads, railroad tracks, trails, waterways, and shorelines than any other county with a total of 2,140 miles cleaned. Volunteers in Bucks (1,603), Somerset (746), Lancaster (661), and Montgomery (632) Counties rounded out the top five counties for mileage cleaned.
- *Beautification* Beautification efforts were most notable in the southeast region of the state with Philadelphia County volunteers planting a total of 2,134 trees, flowers, and bulbs. Lancaster County volunteers planted 984 of the same. However, Cambria County planted 1,583 trees, flowers, and bulbs. The volunteer beautification effort in these three counties accounted for 75% of all trees, flowers, and bulbs planted.
- *Tires collected* Elk County volunteers collected 8,302 tires followed by Allegheny County volunteers with 1,549. Volunteers in Westmoreland County collected 1,127 tires. Collections in these three counties accounted for 46% of all tires collected.
