Project Description: The Crawford County Conservation District planned to offer a county wide cost share program implementing water quality and non point source pollution best management practices to rural lands. The agricultural best management practices were identified from the Pennsylvania Technical Guide. In addition to construction the District initiated the development of 9 Nutrient Management Plans.

Project Goals: The Crawford County Ag BMP Grant will provide benefit to rural water quality through the installation of ten best management practices and five Nutrient Management Plans.

Project Results: In all we completed or contributed to the completion of 30 separate best management practices on 10 farms within Crawford County. We also completed 9 nutrient management plans.
