North Branch Blacklick Creek Stream Improvement Project

Project Description: The Project will install fish enhancement structures to control stream bank erosion on the North Branch Blacklick Creek for approximately 1250 linear feet of stream.

Project Goals: The goals were to improve fish habitat and other aquatic resources while reducing sediment pollution from eroding streambanks into the North Branch Blacklick Creek.

Project Results: The streambanks were sloped and stabilized with fish habitat structures which reduced sediment loading into the stream.
